

# Erratic Rock Senses Poetry

Erratic rocks are rocks which have been moved by giant ice sheets and dropped somewhere new. Some rocks can travel hundreds of miles in the ice.

Ice sheets are a type of glacier. Glaciers flow very slowly, plucking rocks from the ground below and carrying them over long distances.

This picture shows a glacier. The power of glaciers shapes and carves the landscape as it moves.
